**Notes**

1. The student who is dishonest during the Exam will get "0" in that subject. No extra papers/documents are allowed in the exam room. Scratch paper will be provided.
2. All stationery items must be kept in clear plastic bags and put on your desk.
3. Students are not allowed to use their mobile phones and other electronic devices during the exam. All phones must be turned off before the exam begins. Phones are to be kept in a student bag in front of exam room. If students contravene this rule, they will receive a grade of 0 (zero) and will not have the right to take the exam.
4. For multiple choice exams: use a 2B pencil for filling in the circle part ●, student's ID No. and Class No., and a pen for the writing part.
5. Before submitting the exam paper, the student must check its completion. Exam sheets and scratch papers must be returned to the invigilator.
6. Students who will not take the examination on schedule must inform the Academic Affairs (EP) at least 1 day in advance. Otherwise, it means that those students renounce their rights to take those exams.
