**Notes**

1. The student who is dishonest during the Final Exam will get "0" in that subject.
2. All stationery items must be kept in clear plastic bags. No extra papers/documents are allowed in the exam room. Scratch paper will be provided.
3. Students are not allowed to use their mobile phones and other electronic devices during the exam. All phones must be turned off before the exam begins. Phones are to be kept in a student bag in front of exam room. If students contravene this rule, they will receive a grade of 0 (zero) and will not have the right to take the exam.
4. For multiple choice exams: use ● 2B pencil for filling in the circle part I, student's ID No. and Class No., and a pen for the writing part.
5. Before submitting the exam paper, the student must check its completion. Exam sheets and scratch papers must be returned to the invigilator.
6. Students who will not take the examination on schedule must inform the Academic Affairs (EP) at least 1 day in advance. Otherwise, it means that those students renounce their rights to take those exams.
7. The subjects that are not in this timetable will be tested during class periods. Students can view the exam content at [www.ep-ac.com](http://www.ep-ac.com).
8. Students must present their student ID cards or identification cards to the exam room invigilator during the morning line up.

**Students that fail to produce their student ID cards or identification cards cannot sit for the examination.**

**9. After the exam has started: For the first exam of the day, students **MUST** enter the examination room no later than 15 minutes after the scheduled start time.**

**For subsequent exams on the same day, students **MUST** enter no later than 5 minutes after the scheduled start time.**

**Students who arrive later than the specified time will receive a score of zero (0) for the exam.**

**10. After 40 minutes from the start of the exam, students who have completed their exams may leave the examination room.**

11. The Final exam result will be announced on 16<sup>th</sup> of March 2026 at Swis Application for Student.

12. Registration for re-exam will be on 17<sup>th</sup> of March 2026 from 8:00-8:30 a.m. at EP Head Office on 3rd Floor.

**Students who are taking re-exam must be wearing complete school uniform.**

13. Re-exam will be on 17<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>th</sup> of March 2026 and the result will be announced on 23<sup>rd</sup> of March 2026 at Swis Application for Student.
